The home of Pendyrus Male Choir for 70 Years

The vestry of Ebenezer Chapel situated on East Road Tylorstown was made available for rehearsals, and even though it is said that prospective choristers had been seen escaping through windows rather than take the then compulsory voice test, those who did, soon numbered in excess of 150, making the vestry too small to cater comfortably with these numbers. And so they made the short journey across the road from the rear of the chapel and into Tylorstown Primary School, this was to be their home for the next 70 years until May 1999 when they moved to the Rhondda Fach Sports centre whilst refurbishment took place at the school. They then returned to the school in October 1999, but only briefly until a final move back to the Sports Centre in February 2000, this is now their permanent base.
